

MATERIAL ACCEPTED

All brush, tree trimming, and woody material will go into the pile marked **BRUSH**.

Please keep all brush no longer than 6 ft. or 12" in diameter.

All grass clippings, leaves, and garden waste will go into the pile that is marked **GRASS**.

MATERIAL NOT ACCEPTED

Pop cans, plastic, paper, flower pots, railroad ties, landscape timbers, treated wood and even the recycling brown paper bags. We ask all residents to please use care when loading yard waste material into the vehicle and make sure there is none of the above garbage or any other non accepted materials in your load.

Failure to do so will have your load rejected from the facility. Contaminated loads will need to be removed off property and cleaned.

BENEFITS OF HAVING A DUMP CARD

1. No limit on the amount of yard waste generated from your home to be disposed of.
2. Save 10% off all of your mulch, topsoil and compost purchased.
3. Time saving check in process.

When accepting the "Dump Card" you are acknowledging that you will follow all listed rules and will abide by them while utilizing the yard waste recycling facility known as Clean Wood Recycling.

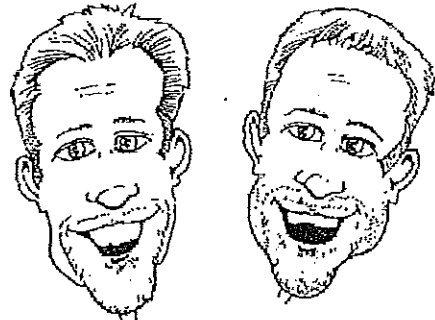

RULES

We are required by OHIO EPA to inspect and record all vehicles and material brought in to our facility. There are times when several residents pull in at the same time or we have to help a resident, we ask that you have patience as we try to help everyone as quickly as we can.

All loads need to be inspected by the Clean Wood Recycling employee.

All loads need to be free of garbage (paper, plastic, metal, pop cans, etc.). Also all branches need to be separated from loose yard waste which includes, grass, leaves, pine needles, flowers etc. Any one who is caught dumping garbage will be banned from further use.

Anyone who dumps without being checked in will face the possibility of being banned from our facility. Please, never drive past the check-in center, if someone is not outside they will be with you as soon as they can.

We have a "NO SMOKING" facility; we ask that all cigarettes or cigars are extinguished prior to entering the facility and that while you are unloading material you refrain from smoking until you leave the facility.

We have a "NO CELL PHONE" facility as well; we ask that all conversations be ended before entering the facility and that you refrain from making calls while you are unloading material. Unfortunately, due to the heavy equipment and other processing equipment on site cell phone use could pose a safety issue.

While on the property there is a 10 mile an hour speed limit, this is there for safety purposes.

We are not permitted to take material beyond our posted hours of operation; failure to follow this rule could result in a citation or a fine. Please don't ask us to dump after hours.

We are required by OHIO EPA to keep yard waste separated, which is why we have two separate piles for disposal. Therefore, we ask that you don't mix yard waste when loading it at your home; it will make it easier to place it in the proper piles. It is your responsibility to empty your bags, cans, or boxes and put the yard waste in the correct piles, also take your bags, cans, or boxes back with you.

All branches being brought in need to be less than 6 foot in length and 10 inches in diameter. There is an \$8.00/yd charge for anything over length and a charge for over diameter depending on the size.

Pallets, Crates, and building material needs to be less than 6 foot in length and clean- no paper, plastic, or cardboard.

We do not accept any wood that has been treated, painted, stained, etc. This includes railroad ties, fences posts, and landscape timbers.

We ask that you make sure all loads coming to the facility are secure. Unsecured loads could be ticketed by law enforcement. Make sure to bring something to cut any twine you may have used to bundle your brush.
