

POLICE OFFICER

The City of Waterville is accepting applications for Police Officer. Duties include patrol, traffic enforcement, investigating crimes, completing written reports, testifying in court, interacting with citizens, and other related duties. Applicants must be at least 21 years of age, but no older than 35 at the time of appointment, possess a high school diploma or GED (college degree is preferred), have a valid Ohio driver's license and a current Ohio Peace Officer certification that meets the requirements of ORC §109.77. A copy of the diploma/degree must be submitted with the application. A copy of the OPOTA peace officer certification must be submitted before completion of all testing. Applicants may not have any felony or domestic violence convictions. Position requires working varied hours, weekends and/or holidays, in all weather conditions. Pre-employment physical and drug test required. Current salary range is \$19.94 to \$24.39 per hour. Applications may be obtained at <http://waterville.org/> or at the Waterville City Hall, 25 N.
