

Drinking Water Notice

After nearly 2 years of planning, engineering and installation, the City of Waterville will be changing our water source from the city of Toledo water supply to the City of Bowling Green water supply. On **February 21, 2017** this change is scheduled to occur.

We do not anticipate any problems with this changeover but there could be some cloudiness or brownish colored water caused by the change in direction of the flow in certain areas of the city. This change in water color would be the same as you would see when the hydrants are flushed.

It is recommended that you turn on a cold water faucet and let run for 3-5 minutes to ensure the water is running clear before doing any laundry. For those who do laundry during this changeover and notice a discoloring of your clothes, a rust remover is available and can be picked up at the Municipal Building.

The most notable change may be in the pressure of the water or possibly a difference of chlorine smell.

If you do have a noticeable change in water quality or pressure, please call the Municipal Office at 419-878-8100 and a Waterville employee will address any concerns you may have.
