## Upcoming Waterline Project

Please be advised that the City of Waterville has hired a contractor to replace the aging waterline along Michigan Avenue / Farnsworth Road, from Wilkshire Drive to the Anthony Wayne Trail. Most of the work will be along the north side of the corridor. At the Anthony Wayne Trail - Farnsworth Road intersection, the new waterline will then be extended northerly along the west side of the Anthony Wayne Trail for 1000 feet, to connect to an existing waterline. The project will not only replace the older line, which is subject to leaks and breaks, but will also increase water flow and pressure throughout the area. The project will start September 4 and extend to November 24. (weather permitting)

The project will require intermittent lane closings along the adjacent roadways with slight delays to motorists. For a couple of days the road will be closed during working hours, with a detour provided via Farnsworth Road to Waterville-Monclova Road to Michigan Avenue. Driveways and side streets will be blocked for short time periods.
