

Notice Regarding Fall 2020 Unlimited Pick Up and New Automated Refuse and Recycling Containers for Residents of the City of Waterville

As of September 30, 2020, the City of Waterville is working to finalize a new refuse and recycling collection contract with Republic Services. As part of this new contract, the City of Waterville will be converting from can/bag collection to the use of automated refuse and recycling containers or “toters” for weekly refuse and bi-weekly recycling collection. Two new containers, one for recycling and one for refuse will be supplied to each residential customer at no charge as part of the new contract. Also, under the new contract, the City will be split into two (2) collection areas for the annual unlimited pick up scheduled for Fall 2020. Unlimited pick up will be conducted in one portion of the City followed one week later by an unlimited collection in the remaining portion of the City. A map indicating which unlimited pick up area you are located in will be provided by the City.

Unfortunately, until a contract is finalized with Republic, the City cannot provide scheduled dates for the delivery of new refuse and recycling containers, the start of automated refuse and recycling collection or the dates of unlimited pick up. As soon as a contract is approved, the City of Waterville will notify all residents of the scheduled dates for the start of these new refuse and recycling services.
