UNDER-SPEED VEHICLES (GOLF CARTS), UTILITY VEHICLES AND MINI-TRUCKS

The authorization to operate these vehicles on public roads is at the discretion of the City of Waterville. (Ohio Revised Code 4511.215)

Each vehicle must successfully pass the required vehicle inspection performed by the Waterville Police Department prior to obtaining certificate of title and registration.

What Do I Need to Bring to the Title Office?

- A completed inspection from local law enforcement
- Application for Certificate of Title to a Motor Vehicle form (BMV 3774)
- Proof of ownership (e.g.): Manufacture Certificate of Origin (MCO), assigned title from this state or another state, bill of sale from a retail business or individual, sworn statement of ownership, or other evidence required by law of another state from which the vehicle was brought into this state
- Payment for title fees, including a lien holder notation (if applicable)

Restriction on Operation of Under-Speed Vehicles (Golf Carts) on Public Streets in the City of Waterville

- May be driven on River Road from the north City limits to Hillside Drive, and on other City streets with speed limit of 25 MPH or lower, under the following restrictions:
 - May <u>directly</u> cross intersecting streets with speed limits greater than 25 MPH, but may not operate on those streets (with the exception of River Road, as stated above):
 - May not operate on sidewalks, walking trails or shared use paths;
 - Operator must have a valid driver's license;
 - Must have valid insurance on the Under-Speed vehicle (golf cart);
 - Headlights must be on (day or night) while driving on City streets;
 - Seatbelts must be used by all occupants;
 - Properly installed child safety seat for any child under the age of 4, or under 40 lbs. in weight;
 - Properly installed booster seat for any child between the ages of 4 and 8, or under 49" in height.
