

ROAD CLOSURE

Farnsworth Road and River Road Intersection Beginning Monday, October 7, 2024 For a period up to 14 Days

Beginning Monday, October 7, 2024, the intersection of Farnsworth Road and River Road will be closed for waterline construction which is scheduled to last for a period up to 14 days. Detour and road closure signage will be placed on Farnsworth and River Roads to provide advance warning to drivers of the road closure area. Drivers traveling south bound on Farnsworth Road should use the Anthony Wayne Trail to access River Road north or south of the construction area. Drivers turning left off the Waterville Bridge onto River Road will have travel north on Mechanic Street to the Anthony Wayne Trail. Drivers traveling northbound on River Road south of Farnsworth Road will have to take South Street to the Anthony Wayne Trail. The area between the "half barricades", such as at Mechanic Street and River Road for example, to the actual closure barricades at the intersection of Farnsworth and River Roads will be open to local traffic. Signage will say: "Road Closed Ahead, Local Traffic Only". The location of the construction area and the detour and road closure signage is indicated on the enclosed map.
