Welcome to the Waterville Safety City Program! The officers, instructors, and volunteers will team up to provide an informative and enjoyable Safety City experience!

Session/Check-In:

Morning Session runs Monday-Friday 9:00am-12:00pm. Check-in begins at 8:45a.
Afternoon Session runs Monday-Friday 1:00pm-4:00pm. Check-in begins at 12:45p.

Safety City is held at **Waterville Primary School, 457 Sycamore Lane, Waterville, OH 43566**. Please report to the Check-In table in the cafeteria for dropping off and picking up your child (a police car will be parked at the northwest doors to enter in). Please be prompt when arriving at the beginning and end of each session.

We will only release the students to who is listed on the registration. If you have someone picking up a student outside of who is listed, please complete the pick-up form and submit it the first day of Safety City. We will require identification from whoever is picking them up.

Kid Print ID:

Attached to this registration are the instructions for Justice for Sierah, if you want a KidPrint ID card. Their online liability form needs to be completed for them to do an ID card for your child(ren). Please complete this by **June 1** to allow them time to process the information for the IDs. There is an attached document to assist you. If you do not complete this, Justice for Sierah and Safety City will consider it as you declining the KidPrint ID card. This is completely optional and students do not lose out on instruction for completing or not completing it.

Safety City shirt sizes may not be exact.. **Please arrive by 5:45p and make sure your child has gone to the bathroom and is wearing their Safety City shirt.** Graduation event is time sensitive due to our building reservation and special guests that are invited.

Justice for Sierah KidPrint ID



The Waterville Safety City Program is proud to welcome Justice for Sierah.

Crystal Mathias is with the Justice for Sierah, a non-profit organization that was created after Sierah Joughin was abducted and murdered. One of their missions is to keep our communities safe and to do so, they created Sierah Strong for the Community where they teach self-defense and self-awareness to our youth. During those events, they offer their KidPrint ID for every attendee.

These are very important cards as they contain vital information including height, weight, eye color, hair color, and most importantly a fingerprint. When Sierah first went missing, the police asked her mother if she had anything with her fingerprint and fortunately, she had one of these cards.

Each attendee will receive a KidPrint ID and a presentation on personal safety. They do not sell any of this information nor do they solicit, they will not be on a mailing list.
